Rule 15-405. MCLE requirements for licensed paralegal practitioner on inactive status.

- (a) Licensed paralegal practitioner on inactive status are not subject to MCLE requirements
 while on inactive status.
- 3 (b) Return to active status. A licensed paralegal practitioner who is on inactive status for 12
- 4 months or more and who returns to active status must complete the 24 hour MCLE requirement
- 5 by June 30 of the fiscal year following his or her return to active status and may use CLE hours
- 6 completed prior to activation to satisfy part or all of the MCLE requirement if those hours were
- 7 completed during the CLE cycle in which the lawyer must complete the MCLE requirement.
- 8 (c) A licensed paralegal practitioner who has been on inactive status for less than 12 months
- 9 <u>may not elect active status until completing the MCLE requirements that were incomplete at the</u>
- 10 time the licensed paralegal practitioner elected to be enrolled as an inactive licensed paralegal
- 11 <u>practitioner.</u>
