2	
3	Intent:
4	To establish a procedure for handling cases in which the defendant fails to appear and fails to
5	forfeit bail <u>remit a fine</u> .
6	
7	Applicability:
8	This rule shall apply to cases in which the defendant's appearance is not required.
9	
10	Statement of the Rule:
11	(1) When a case is filed, the clerk may mail to the defendant a notice indicating the bail fine
12	amount. If the defendant fails to appear or forfeit the bailremit the fine amount within fourteen
13	days after receiving a citation, the clerk may increase the bail fine amount by \$50 and mail the
14	defendant a delinquency notice.
15	
16	(2) If the defendant fails to appear or forfeit the bailremit the fine amount within forty days after
17	receiving a citation, the court may increase the bail <u>fine</u> amount by \$75 and issue a warrant for
18	failure to appear.

20	(3) If the defendant is a juvenile, the court may issue a bench warrant or order to take the
21	defendant into custody. If a bench warrant is issued, a special designation or "flag" shall be
