1 Rule 32. Initiation of ungovernability and runaway cases.

- 2 (a) Proceedings involving a child alleged to be beyond control of the child's parent, guardian or
- 3 lawful custodian, or alleged to be a runaway, shall be initiated by petition.
- 4 (b) A petition shall be accepted by the clerk only if it is filed by the Division of Child and Family
- 5 <u>Juvenile Justice</u> Services or a contract agency of the Division.
- 6 (c) The petition must allege the earnest and persistent efforts by the agency, the child's out of
- 7 control behavior, the behavior or other condition that endangers the child's welfare or the
- 8 welfare of others, and the actions taken which have failed to correct the behavior. In the
- 9 alternative, the allegations may be made by affidavit accompanying the petition.
