- 1 Rule 14-714. Unsuccessful Applicants: disclosure and right of inspection.
- 2 (a) Inspection of the Written Component. The Written Component of the Bar Examination shall
- 3 be retained for no fewer than six months after the date that examination's results have been
- 4 announced. An unsuccessful Applicant shall be entitled to a reasonable inspection of the
- 5 Applicant's answers to the MEE and MPT questions of the examination.
- 6 (b) The MEE and MPT questions and analyses are available from the NCBE.
- 7 (c) Privileged Information is not subject to disclosure.
- 8 (d) Inspection of MBE. This rule does not permit an Applicant to inspect MBE questions or her or
- 9 his answers. Neither copies of the MBE questions nor answers are retained by the Bar.
- 10 (e) All disclosure under this rule is governed by Rule 14-720.
