- 5 **T**the district courts, Committee members, special counsel appointed pursuant to Rule
- 6 14-517(f)11-542, supervising attorneys engaged in pro bono assistance, trustees
- 7 appointed pursuant to Rule <u>14-52711-538</u>, and OPC <u>cC</u>ounsel and staff <u>shall will</u> be
- 8 immune from suit, except as provided in Utah Rules of Civil Procedure 65A and 65B,
- 9 for any conduct committed in the course of their official duties, including the
- investigatory stage. There is no immunity from civil suit for intentional misconduct.
