- 25 [(d)] (e) Professionalism and Civility. All courses or components of courses offered to
- fulfill the [professionalism and civility] Professionalism and Civility CLE requirement
- under 14-404(a) must be specifically Accredited by the Board.
- [(e)] (f) Undue hardship; special Accreditation. Formal instruction or educational
- seminars [which] that meet the requirements of paragraph (a) lend themselves well to
- the fulfillment of the educational requirement imposed by this article and will be readily
- Accredited by the Board. It is not intended that compliance with this article will impose
