- 2 <u>Practitioners on active status outside of Utah:</u> Lawyers <u>or paralegal practitioners</u>

- 4 (a) A lawyer on active status who is not engaged in the practice of law in Utah, or a
- 5 paralegal practitioner on active status who is not engaged in practice in Utah, may[,] file
