1 Rule 13. Shelter hearings.

- 2 (a) Shelter hearings shall be conducted in accordance with <u>Utah Code Sections</u> 78A-6-
- 3 306 80-3-301 and Section 78A-6-307 80-3-302.
- 4 (b) The Division of Child and Family Services shall file with the court at or before the
- shelter hearing a copy of the notice form required by Section Utah Code section 62A-4a-
- 6 202.2 and the notice required by Section Utah Code section 78A 6 306 80-3-301.
- 7 (c) At the beginning of the shelter hearing, the court shall advise all persons present of
- 8 the information submitted to the court as a basis for the admission of the minor into
- 9 shelter care and of the scope and purpose of the hearing.
- 10 (d) The court may receive any information, including hearsay and opinions, that is
- 11 relevant to the issue of whether it is safe to release the minor to the parent, guardian or
- custodian. Privileged communications may be admitted only in accordance with the rules
- 13 of evidence.
- 14 (e) If the parent, guardian, or custodian of the minor cannot be notified as provided in
- 15 <u>Utah Code section 78A-6-306</u> 80-3-301, a shelter hearing may be held without the
- 16 minor's parent, guardian or custodian. Upon a finding that a continuance is necessary for
- 17 the protection of the minor, for the accumulation or presentation of necessary evidence,
- to protect the rights of a party, or for other good cause, the court may continue the hearing
- in accordance with <u>Utah Code section</u> <u>78A-6-306</u> <u>80-3-301</u>.
- 20 (f) If the minor is not released, the order for continued shelter shall be furnished to the
- 21 agency responsible for shelter care of minors in the county. Orders for continued shelter
- care shall be of definite duration and may be extended upon review at a hearing in
- conformity with Utah Code sectionSection 78A-6-306 80-3-301 and this rule.
- 24 (g) The release of the minor from shelter care may be requested by the court, a party, or
- 25 any person interested in the minor at any time on the grounds that the conditions giving
- rise to the placement no longer exist or no longer justify continuing shelter. Such request

- shall be considered by the court at a hearing in conformity with <u>Utah Code section</u>Section
