- 1 Rule 51. Violation of probation and contempt by a minor.
- 2 (a) Any minor may be found in contempt of court for an act committed in the presence
- 3 of the court.
- 4 (b) Contempt proceedings for actions alleged to have been committed by a minor
- 5 outside of the presence of the court may be commenced by either of the following
- 6 methods:
- 7 (b)(1) Affidavit and order to show cause. An affidavit setting forth the facts of the
- 8 alleged contempt shall be filed with the court. Based upon the affidavit, the court
- 9 may execute an order to show cause ordering the minor's parent, guardian or
- custodian to produce the minor in court at a date, place, and time certain. A copy
- of the affidavit and the order to show cause shall be personally served upon the
- minor's parent, guardian or custodian if they fail to appear in response to service

- 14 (b)(2) Petition. A separate petition may be filed and may include an allegation of
