## 1 Rule 20. Discovery generally.

- 2 (a) Discovery involving adjudications of delinquency, offenses by adults against minors,
- 3 and proceedings brought pursuant to <u>Title 80, Chapter 6, Part 5, Transfer to District</u>
- 4 <u>CourtSection 78A 6 702 and Section 78A 6 703</u> shall be conducted in accordance with
- 5 Utah R. Cr. P. 16 Rule 16 of the Utah Rules of Criminal Procedure, except where limited
- 6 by these rules, the Code of Judicial Administration, or the Juvenile Court Act Utah
- 7 <u>Juvenile Code</u>.
- 8 (b) In substantiation cases, no later than thirty days prior to trial, parties shall provide to
- 9 each other information necessary to support its claims or defenses unless otherwise
- 10 ordered by the court.
- 11 (c) Rule 26.1 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure does not apply in any juvenile
- 12 proceedings unless there is a showing of good cause and it is ordered by the court.
- 13 (d) In all other cases, discovery shall be conducted pursuant to these rules unless
- 14 modified by a showing of good cause and by order of the court.
