- 3 (a) Exemption from future testimony. No Fee Dispute Resolution Committee member

- 5 called as a witness in any subsequent legal proceeding related to the fee dispute.
- 6 (b) Confidentiality of records and information. Records and Linformation and
- 7 documentation submitted in a fee dispute proceeding shall be deemed confidential and
- 8 shall <u>may</u> not be disclosed other than to enforce a written decision <u>or as provided in</u>
- 9 <u>paragraph (c)</u>.
- 10 (c) Notwithstanding the above, cDisclosure of confidential information. Confidential
- 11 information in the Utah State Bar's possession may be disclosed to law enforcement to
- 12 the extent disclosure is necessary to prevent reasonably certain death or substantial
- 13 <u>bodily harm. Confidential information in the Utah State Bar's possession</u> may <u>also</u> be
- 14 disclosed if the request is made to the Bar by:
