

1 Rule 14-403. Establishment and membership of Board.

32 (a) Establishment. There is established by this Court a Board of Mandatory Continuing
43 Legal Education. The Board comprises ~~15~~ 10 members, at least ~~8~~ 13 of whom are lawyers
54 admitted to the Bar, and up to 2 of whom may be paralegal practitioners.

65 (b) Terms. Members are appointed for staggered ~~three~~ four-year terms. No lawyer or
76 paralegal practitioner may serve more than two consecutive terms as a member of the
87 Board unless appointed by the Supreme Court as the Board chair or when justified by
98 special circumstances, as determined by the Supreme Court. The Board may also have up to
109 two nonvoting emeritus members. An emeritus member has the same authority and duties
1110 as other Board members, except that the member does not have authority to vote. An
1211 emeritus member may serve two terms in addition to the terms served as a member.

1312 (c) Application and recruitment of committee members. Vacancies on the Board shall be
1413 announced in a manner reasonably calculated to reach members of the Utah State Bar. The
1514 notice shall specify a brief description of the Board's responsibilities, the method for
1615 submitting an application or letter of interest, and the application deadline. Members of the
1716 Board or the Supreme Court may solicit applications for membership on the Board.
1817 Applications and letters of interest shall be submitted to the Supreme Court.

1918 (d) Appointment of committee members and chair. Upon expiration of the application
2019 deadline, the Supreme Court shall review the applications and letters of interest and
2120 appoint those individuals who are best suited to serve on the Board. In the event of a mid-
2221 term vacancy the Supreme Court shall appoint a new member to serve for the remainder of
2322 the term. The Supreme Court shall select a chair from among the Board's members.

2423 (e) Absences. In the event a Board member fails to attend three Board meetings during a
2524 calendar year, the chair may notify the Supreme Court of those absences and may request
2625 that the Supreme Court replace that Board member.

26 (f) Administrative assistance. The MCLE Director will support the Board.
