- 2 (a) **Requirements of Student Applicants.** The burden of proof is on the Applicant to
- 3 establish by clear and convincing evidence that the Applicant:
- 4 (1) has paid the prescribed fees and timely filed the required Complete Application as
- 5 a Student Applicant in accordance with <u>Rule 14-707</u>;
- 6 (2) is at least 21 years old;
- 7 (3) has graduated with a First Professional Degree in law from an Approved Law
- 8 School;
- 9 (4) is of good moral character and satisfies the requirements of Rule 14-708;
- 10 (5) has successfully passed the MPRE and the Bar Examination either;
- 11 (i)successfully passed the Bar Examination; or
- 12 (ii) is qualified for, and has completed the requirements of, the Alternate Path for
- 13 Student Applicants under Rule 14-703A;
- 14 (6) has a proven record of ethical, civil and professional behavior; and
- 15 (7) complies with the provisions of <u>Rule 14-716</u> concerning licensing and enrollment
- 16 fees.
