1	Rule 1.12. Arbitrator, Mediator or Other Third-Party Neutral.
2	(a) A licensed paralegal practitioner shall not represent anyone in connection with a matter in
3	which the licensed paralegal practitioner participated personally and substantially as an
4	arbitrator, mediator or other third-party neutral, unless all parties to the proceeding give informed
5	consent, confirmed in writing.
6	(b) A licensed paralegal practitioner shall not negotiate for employment with any person who
7	is involved as a party or as counsel for a party in a matter in which the licensed paralegal
8	practitioner is participating personally and substantially as an arbitrator, mediator or other third-
9	party neutral.
10	(c) If a licensed paralegal practitioner is disqualified by paragraph (a), no attorney or licensed
11	paralegal practitioner in a firm with which that licensed paralegal practitioner is associated
12	may knowingly undertake or continue representation in the matter unless:
13	(c)(1) the disqualified licensed paralegal practitioner is timely screened from any
14	participation in the matter and is apportioned no part of the fee from that matter; and
15	(c)(2) written notice is promptly given to the parties and any appropriate tribunal.
