- practice in communications about the licensed paralegal practitioner's services. If a licensed
- paralegal practitioner practices only in certain fields or will not accept matters except in a
- specified field or fields, the licensed paralegal practitioner is required to so indicate. A licensed
- paralegal practitioner is generally permitted to state that the licensed paralegal practitioner is a
- "specialist," practices a "specialty" or "specializes in" particular fields, but such communications
- are subject to the "false and misleading" standard applied in Rule 7.1 to communications
