11	[1] Assessments by licensed paralegal practitioners are relied on in evaluating the professional or
12	personal fitness of persons being considered for election or appointment to judicial office.
13	Expressing honest and candid opinions on such matters contributes to improving the
14	administration of justice. Conversely, false statements by a licensed paralegal practitioner can
15	unfairly undermine public confidence in the administration of justice.

17	[3] To maintain the fair and independent administration of justice, licensed paralegal
18	practitioners are encouraged to continue traditional efforts to defend judges and courts unjustly
19	criticized.
