- 3 As used in this article:
- 4 (a) "Bar" means Utah State Bar, a corporation incorporated, registered and domiciled in
- 5 Utah and designated as a Section 501(c)(6) organization under the United States
- 6 Internal Revenue Code;
- 7 (b) "Board" means the Board of Commissioners of the Utah State Bar;
- 8 (c) "commissioner" means a member of the Board;
- 9 (d) "Executive Committee" means a committee of not fewer than three members of the
- 10 Board as set forth in these Bylaws;
- (e) "executive director" means the executive director of the Bar;
- (f) "member" means a lawyer who has been admitted to the Bar who holds a current
- active or inactive license, or is a licensed foreign legal consultant;
- (g) "president" means the president of the Board;
- (h) "president-elect" means the president-elect of the Board; and
- (i) "Supreme Court" means the Utah Supreme Court.
- 17 (j) "Licensed Paralegal Practitioner" means a person licensed by the Utah Supreme Court to
- provide limited legal representation in the areas of (1) temporary separation, divorce, parentage,
- 19 cohabitant abuse, civil stalking, custody and support, and name change; (2) forcible entry and
- 20 <u>detainer</u>; or (3) debt collection matters in which the dollar amount in issue does not exceed the
- 21 <u>statutory limit for small claims cases.</u>
