Rule 14-105 Conduct of licensed lawyers, <u>Licensed Paralegal Practitioners</u> and judicial officers; complaints, investigations, and discipline.

(a) The Board shall formulate rules governing the conduct of all persons admitted to
practice in Utah, including foreign legal consultants <u>and those licensed as Licensed</u>
<u>Paralegal Practitioners</u>, and shall investigate unethical, questionable or improper
conduct of persons admitted to the practice of the law, including members of the Bar
holding judicial office. The Board shall also formulate rules governing procedures in
cases involving alleged misconduct of members of the Bar, including those holding
judicial office.

- 10 (b) Court to approve rules and regulations. All rules and regulations formulated by the
- Board shall be submitted to and approved by the Supreme Court.
