1 Rule 15-404. Active status licensed paralegal practitioners: MCLE.

2 (a) Active status licensed paralegal practitioners. Commencing with calendar year 2018,

- 3 <u>each paralegal practitioner licensed to practice in Utah must complete, during each two</u>
- 4 fiscal year period (July 1 through June 30), a minimum of 12 hours of Utah accredited
- 5 CLE which must include a minimum of three hours of accredited ethics or professional
- 6 responsibility. One of the three hours of ethics or professional responsibility must be in
- 7 the area of professionalism and civility. Licensed paralegal practitioners on inactive
- 8 status are not subject to the requirements of this rule.

- 14 (g) Out-of-state CLE activities. CLE credit may be awarded for out-of-state activities that
- the Board determines meet standards in furthering a licensed paralegal practitioner's
- legal education. The Board determines whether to accredit the activities and, if
- 17 <u>accredited, the number of hours of credit to allow for such activities.</u>
- 18 (h) Activities that may be regarded as equivalent to state-sponsored self-study CLE may
- include, but are not limited to, viewing of approved CLE audio, video, and webcast
- 20 <u>presentations, computer interactive telephonic programs, writing and publishing an</u>
- 21 article in a legal periodical, part-time teaching in an approved law school or approved
- 22 paralegal education program, or delivering a paper or speech on a professional subject
- 23 at a meeting primarily attended by lawyers, licensed paralegal practitioners, legal
- 24 assistants, or law school students.
- 25 (i) A licensed paralegal practitioner's application for accreditation of a CLE activity must
- be submitted in writing to the Board if the activity has not been previously approved for
- 27 CLE credit in Utah.
