## 1 Rule 15-409. Self-study categories of accredited MCLE defined.

- 2 (a) Lecturing, teaching, and panel discussions. Licensed paralegal practitioners who
- 3 lecture in an accredited CLE program will receive credit for three hours for each hour
- 4 spent lecturing. No lecturing or teaching credit is available for participation in a panel
- 5 <u>discussion or for preparation time.</u>
- 6 (b) Final published course schedule. The Board will determine the number of accredited
- 7 <u>CLE hours available for a program based on the final published course schedule.</u>
- 8 (c) Equivalent CLE credit for certain self-study activities. Subject to the Board's
- 9 determination, the Board will allow equivalent credit for such activities that further the
- 10 purpose of this article and qualify for equivalency. Such equivalent activities may
- include, but are not limited to, viewing of approved CLE audio, video, and webcast
- 12 presentations, computer interactive telephonic programs, writing and publishing an
- 13 <u>article in a legal periodical, part-time teaching by a licensed paralegal practitioner in an</u>
- 14 approved law school or approved paralegal education program, or delivering a paper or
- 15 speech on a professional subject at a meeting primarily attended by lawyers, licensed
- paralegal practitioners, legal assistants or law students. The number of hours of credit
- 17 allowed for such activities and the procedures for obtaining equivalent credit will be
- determined specifically by the Board for each instance.
