- 1 Rule 14-403. Establishment and membership of Board.
- 2 (a) Establishment. There is hereby established by this Court a Board of Mandatory
- 3 Continuing Legal Education. The Board consists of 15 members, all of
- 4 whom are lawyers admitted to the Bar.
- 5 (b) Terms. Members are appointed for staggered four-yearthree-year terms, . except
- that three members of the initial Board will be appointed for a one-year term and three
- 7 members will be appointed for a two-year term. No lawyer may serve more than two
- 8 consecutive terms as a member of the Board unless appointed by the Supreme Court
- 9 as the Board chair or when justified by special circumstances. The Board may also have
- up to two nonvoting emeritus members. An emeritus member has the same authority
- and duties as other Board members, except that such member shall have no authority
- to vote. An emeritus member may serve two terms in addition to the terms served as a
- 13 <u>member.</u>
- (c) Application and recruitment of committee members. Vacancies on the Board shall be
- announced in a manner reasonably calculated to reach members of the Utah State Bar.
- The notice shall specify a brief description of the Board's responsibilities, the method for
- submitting an application or letter of interest, and the application deadline. Members of
- the Board or the Supreme Court may solicit applications for membership on the Board.
- 19 Applications and letters of interest shall be submitted to the Supreme Court.
- 20 (d) Appointment of committee members and chair. Upon expiration of the application
- 21 deadline, the Supreme Court shall review the applications and letters of interest and
- appoint those individuals who are best suited to serve on the Board. In the event of a
- 23 mid-term vacancy the Supreme Court shall appoint a new member to serve for the
- remainder of the term. The Supreme Court shall select a chair from among the Board's
- 25 members.
- 26 (e) Absences. In the event a Board member fails to attend three Board meetings during
- a calendar year, the chair may notify the Supreme Court of those absences and may
- request that the Supreme Court replace that Board member.

- 30 (f) Administrative assistance. The MCLE Director will support the Board.
