2 Rule 32. Initiation of ungovernability and runaway cases.

- 3 (a) Proceedings involving a minorchild alleged to be beyond control of the minor's child's
- 4 parent, guardian or <u>lawful</u> custodian or school authorities, or alleged to be a runaway, shall be
- 5 initiated by petition.
- 6 (b) A petition shall be accepted by the clerk only if it is filed by the Division of Child and Family7 Services or a contract agency of the Division.
- 8 (c) The petition must allege the earnest and persistent efforts by the agency, the minor's child's
- 9 out of control behavior, the behavior or other condition that endangers the <u>minor'schild's</u> welfare
- 10 or the welfare of others, and the actions taken which have failed to correct the behavior. In the
- 11 alternative, the allegations may be made by affidavit accompanying the petition.
