1 Rule 14-1102. Purpose and composition of the committee.

- 2 (a) The purpose of the Committee is to resolve fee disputes between attorneys lawyers
- and their clients by means of arbitration, mediation, or other alternative dispute
- 4 resolution mechanisms.
- 5 (b) The Committee shall will consist of such number of members as may be determined
- 6 annually by appointed annually by the president of the Bar. The president of the Bar
- 7 shall-will designate one of the members of the Committee as the chair. At the discretion
- 8 of the president, a vice chair and/or secretary may be appointed from the members of
- 9 the Committee.
- 10 (c) Participation in the fee arbitration process is non-mandatory. <u>However, If if</u> all the
- 11 necessary parties elect in writing to arbitrate, however, the decision is binding.
- 12 (d). After all parties have agreed in writing to be bound by an arbitration decision, a
- 13 party may not withdraw from that agreement unless all parties agree to the withdrawal in
- 14 writing.
