- 2 (a) Remote Group CLE is one method by which an attorney may obtain Live CLE.
- 3 (b) Remote Group CLE must:
- 4 (b)(i) be presented from a location in Utah via a live streaming audio-visual presentation

- 5 to a remote location or remote locations in Utah, approved by the Board, where the
- 6 <u>lawyer or paralegal practitioner is present;</u>
- 7 (b)(ii) allow attendees to ask, and receive answers to, questions during the CLE
- 8 presentation via voice or an electronic method; and
- 9 (b)(iii) be sponsored or cosponsored by the Bar.
- 10 (c) A person who applies for approval of a remote location shall:
- (c)(i) ensure that the location is large enough to allow at least ten lawyers or paralegal
- 12 <u>practitioners to attend at the remote location and to accommodate more lawyers or</u>
- paralegal practitioners than the number that will attend from the same firm or office;
- (c)(ii) ensure that the remote location is open to any member of the Bar who wishes to
- attend at the remote location, subject to maximum occupancy requirements; and
- (c)(iii) within five days after the day of the Remote CLE, provide the Bar with a list
- containing the names and Bar numbers of each attorney and each paralegal practitioner
- who attended the CLE at the remote location.
- (d) Remote location approval for Remote Group CLE occurs as follows:

- 20 (d)(i) The Bar will post notice of the Remote Group CLE on the Bar's website at least 30
- 21 days before the day of the CLE, including in the notice the process and deadline to
- 22 apply for approval of a remote location.
- 23 (d)(ii) No later than seven days before the day of the CLE, a person may apply to the
- 24 <u>Utah State Bar CLE Department for approval of a remote location.</u>
- 25 (d)(iii) The application for approval of a remote location must include: the title of the
- 26 CLE; the address of the remote location; a description of the remote location, including
- 27 the maximum occupancy of the remote location; a description of the equipment that will
- be used at the remote location to comply with the communication requirements; the
- 29 <u>name and contact information of a person who will be available during presentation of</u>
- the CLE to resolve any technical issues relating to communication and communication
- equipment at the remote location; subject to maximum occupancy requirements, a
- 32 <u>statement that any member of the Bar is able to attend the CLE at the remote location</u>
- at no cost other than the cost imposed by the CLE provider for the CLE; and any other
- information required by the Board.
- (d)(iv) Upon approval by the Bar of the remote location, the Bar will post notice of the
- remote location on the Bar's website.
