

1 **11-706 Non-traditional Legal Providers Assisting Clients in Court**

2 Effective xx/xx/xx

3 (a) **Allowable conduct.** If expressly authorized by the Supreme Court, a non-  
4 traditional legal service provider affiliated with an approved sandbox entity may  
5 provide the following limited assistance to a client in any justice, juvenile,  
6 district, or appellate court of the State of Utah.

- 7 1. Stand or sit at counsel’s table with the client during the proceeding;
- 8 2. Provide advice and assistance to the client during the proceeding, including  
9 prompting a client on how to engage with the court;
- 10 3. Respond to any questions from the court directed to the non-traditional legal  
11 service provider; and
- 12 4. Communicate with an unrepresented party or the party’s lawyer outside of  
13 court regarding the proceeding.

14 (b) **Compliance with rules, regulations, and statutes; notice to the court.** A non-  
15 traditional legal service provider authorized to provide assistance under this rule  
16 must:

- 17 1. Comply with all rules, regulations, and statutes of the State of Utah, except  
18 for those rules expressly waived in the authorization order; and
- 19 2. Orally advise the court that the provider is assisting a client pursuant to this  
20 rule and express authorization from the Supreme Court. The provider must  
21 provide the court with a copy of the authorization if requested by the court.
