- 4 (a) In hearings other than those governed by Rule 29B, the court, for good cause and on its
- 5 own initiative or on motion, may permit a party or a minor's parent, guardian, or custodian
- 6 to attend any proceeding by remote conferencing from a different location unless
- 7 otherwise prohibited by law or rule.
- 8 (b) For good cause and with appropriate safeguards, the court may permit testimony in
- 9 open court by remote conferencing from a different location.
- 10 (c) The remote conference must enable:
- 11 (c)(1) a party and the party's counsel to communicate confidentially;
- 12 (c)(2) documents, photos and other things that are delivered in the courtroom to be
- 13 delivered previously or simultaneously to the remote participants;
- 14 (c)(3) interpretation for a person of limited English proficiency; and
- 15 (c)(4) a verbatim record of the hearing.
- 16 (d) If the court permits remote conferencing, the court may require a party to make the
- 17 arrangements for the remote conferencing.
