- 4 admission to the Bar persons who possess the necessary qualifications of learning, ability and
- 5 character which are a prerequisite to the privilege of engaging in the Practice of Law, and who
- 6 fulfill the requirements for admission to the Bar as provided by this article.
- 7 (b) Subpoena power. The Executive Director, the General Counsel and the Deputy General
- 8 Counsel shall have power to issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses or for the production
- 9 of documentary evidence before the Board or before anyone authorized to act on its behalf.
- 10 (c) Administration of oaths. Members of the Board, the Executive Director and their designees
- shall have power to administer oaths in furtherance of this article.
- 12 (d) Taking of testimony. Members of the Board, the Executive Director and their designees shall
- have the power to take testimony in furtherance of this article.
- 14 (e) Regulations. The Board is empowered to appoint committees or persons who may adopt and
