

Rule 1-590. Reinstatement following a suspension of no more than six months or probation.

A Respondent who has been suspended for no more than six months or placed on probation pursuant to disciplinary proceedings will be reinstated at the end of the suspension or probation upon filing with the district court and serving on the OPC an unsworn declaration stating that the Respondent has fully complied with the requirements of the suspension or probation order and that the Respondent has fully reimbursed the Bar's Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection ~~or Licensed Paralegal Practitioners' Fund for Client Protection~~ for any amounts paid on account of the Respondent's conduct. Within 14 days of service of the Respondent's declaration, the OPC may file an objection. ~~and t~~The district court will then determine whether the Respondent may be reinstated, holding a hearing if warranted.
