1. <u>WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

Mr. Burton welcomed the members of the committee. Mr. Wunderli moved for adoption of the minutes of the meeting held on August 21, 2006. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

2. <u>POSSIBLE AREA OF REVIEW</u>

Mr. Burton advised that the Bar in Florida has recently imposed a restriction on lawyer advertising by requiring advertisements to be approved by the Florida Bar in advance of circulation or distribution. Mr. Burton inquired as to whether the committee had an interest in pursuing a similar provision. Members of the committee expressed no interest in pursuing the issue at the present time.

3. <u>DISCUSSION AS TO RECOMMENDATION OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL'S STANDING COMMITTEE ON RESOURCES FOR SELF-REPRESENTED PARTIES</u>

Mr. Sackett said that the subcommittee consisting of himself, Mr.

Wunderli, Ms. Honarvar, and Mr. Johnson met to consider the standing committee's recommendation that Rule 1.0, Chapter 13A of the Supreme Court Rule of Professional Practice (now renumbered as Rule 14-802) be amended to permit non-lawyers to assist individuals to complete any court-provided form provided no fee is charged for such assistance. Mr. Sackett advised that the subcommittee recommends approval of the amendment with section (c)(3) to provide as follows:

(c)(3) Providing clerical assistance to another to complete a form provided by a court when no fee is charged to do so.

Mr. Chrystler questioned whether there might be forms issued by some courts in the state that might be problematic. Judge Roth wondered whether the provision should be limited to forms provided by courts for use by pro se parties. Mr. Chrystler wondered whether the type of forms should be limited to those forms prepared by the court where the underlying action is filed. Following discussion of the foregoing issues, the consensus of the committee was that any form provided by a court should not be of concern to the committee.

Mr. Johnson moved that the full committee approve the recommendation as to (c)(3) recommended by the subcommittee. Mr. Wunderli seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Burton requested Ms. Branch to advise the Supreme Court as to the committee's position.

4. <u>DISCUSSION AS TO ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS OF SUBCOMMITTEE</u>

Mr. Sackett described the other subcommittee recommendations as to the location of "special practice areas" and further amendment to the Authorization to Practice Law rule. Mr. Sackett stated that he was not expecting the committee to vote on these recommendations at this meeting, but that he was looking for authorization from the committee to discuss these recommendations with Katherine Fox and possibly with Victoria Kidman who chairs the Unauthorized Practice of Law Committee.

Mr. Burton expressed some concern that the recommendations went beyond the scope of what the Supreme Court asked the committee to consider; however, he felt the recommendations seemed to make sense. Mr. Johnson moved that the subcommittee continue to explore the recommendations and to seek input from "interested" parties such as, but not limited to, the Bar's general counsel, the Bar's Admissions Department, and the Unauthorized Practice of Law Committee. Mr. Wunderli seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. Mr. Sackett said he would set up a meeting with the subcommittee and interested parties or entities and report back to the committee at its next meeting.
