Voluntary Bail Forfeiture

Policy:

1. A person may voluntarily forfeit bail for offenses which do not require a mandatory court appearance.

Procedures:

Responsibility Action

District Court Clerk

1. As set out in the <u>Uniform Fine & Bail Schedule</u> a person may voluntarily forfeit bail without appearance being required in any case of a class B misdemeanor or less.

Juvenile Court Clerk

- 1. If the minor comes into the courthouse and admits to the charge, a consent agreement is signed by the minor and parent or legal guardian. The consent agreement is then returned to the courthouse where the clerk shall enter the accounting as a citation Penalty Assessment if the citation is for curfew or tobacco.
- 2. If the citation is for wildlife or traffic violations, the accounting is entered as a Non-judicial Assessment.
