Disposition of bail when paid by a Surety:

- 1. Per UCA 77-20-9(2) when a financial condition was paid by a surety, CORIS distributes as follows:
 - a. 60% Pretrial Release Program (rev code CJ)
 - b. 20% to the General Fund (rev code (FB)
 - c. 20% to the prosecutor (rev code FP)
- 2. The allocation of the 20% is reimbursed to prosecution by the Administrative Office along with monthly payments as identified in Section 02-10.05 Distribution of Fine according to 78A-5-110(2).

Disposition of bail when ordered forfeited:

- 3. Per UCA 77-20-9(2) when bail is posted (by a defendant) and ordered forfeited to the state, CORIS distributes as follows:
 - d. 75% Pretrial Release Program (rev code CJ)
 - e. 25 % to the General Fund (rev code (FB)
