Law Library Non-Lapsing Account

The appellate courts shall receive a \$50 fee for a certificate of admission as attorney and counselor, \$30 of which shall be distributed by the state treasurer to the Judicial Council as a dedicated credit for the benefit of the State Law Library as per Statutory Reference: UCA 78A-9-102 Fees for certificate of admission.

These funds are in a non-lapsing dedicated credit and are allowed to be carried forward to the new budget year. These funds are used for one time purchases to benefit the Law Library and its patrons.
