This letter is issued to evidence the appointment, qualification, and authority of \_\_\_\_\_ (names)  
as guardians for the protected person. **This is a limited guardianship.**

The guardians have the authority to make decisions about the protected person's:

- physical health and medical needs, treatment, and services
- mental health and mental health counseling, treatment and services
- living situation and residence
- care, comfort, and maintenance
- training and education
- clothing, furniture, vehicles, and other personal effects

The guardians have the power to perform the following duties for the protected person:

- give consent necessary so that the respondent can receive medical or other professional care, counsel, treatment, or service
- start proceedings to compel a person with a responsibility to the protected person to perform their duty to support the respondent
- receive money and personal property for the respondent and apply the money and personal property for the respondent's support, care, and education
- start proceedings if the property needs protection
- other (Describe additional authority that the guardians have.)

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The protected person under guardianship has the right to:

- be represented by counsel after a guardian is appointed
- have an interested person raise issues at a guardianship hearing
- receive a copy of all guardianship documents
- receive information about guardianships from the court
- ask the court questions and express concerns about the guardians
- be granted the greatest degree of freedom possible
- be treated with dignity and respect
- be treated fairly by the guardians
- receive the guardians' service at a reasonable compensation rate
- through court review, avoid excessive or unnecessary billing
- receive prudent financial management
- receive a copy of an accounting on frequency determined by court
- ask the court to review the guardians' management activity, the need for a guardianship, and for termination of the guardianship and
- the other rights listed under Utah Code 75-5-301.5.
