This matter is before the court on the Petitioner's Petition for Divorce. The parties have entered into a stipulation, which has been filed with the court. The court having made and entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, now makes and enters the following:

DECREE OF DIVORCE

1. Residency. Respondent is a bona fide resident of Utah County, State of Utah and has been for three months immediately prior to the filing of this action.
2. Marriage Statistics. Petitioner and Respondent were married on October 12, 2022 and are presently married.
3. Grounds. Since the marriage of the parties, there have arisen irreconcilable differences between the parties, making it impossible to continue the marital relationship.
4. Divorce. Petitioner is granted a Decree of Divorce based upon irreconcilable differences.
5. Children. The parties are the parents of four children all of which are now adults.
6. Jurisdiction. This Court has jurisdiction and venue is properly placed in the Fourth District Court, Utah County, State of Utah.
7. Alimony. Both parties are able to provide support for themselves.
8. Both parties have waived spousal support as against the other.
9. No spousal support is awarded to either party.
10. Real Property. The parties are the owners of a residence at 1084 South 1000 East #15, Provo, Utah 84606.
11. Annamae shall retain all ownership, equity and debt related to the residence.
12. Personal Property. The Parties have physically separated the household items and furniture to their satisfaction and each Party is awarded the furniture and household items currently in their possession.
13. Each of the parties are awarded their own personal effects.

14. Bank and Retirement Accounts. Each party is awarded the bank accounts that are in their individual names.
15. Each party is awarded the retirement accounts that have been generated through their own respective employers.
16. Debts. The parties are unaware of any joint marital debt.
17. Each party shall pay any debts in their individual names or for which they personally have incurred.
18. Each party shall indemnify and hold the other party harmless from any liability associated with any debts assumed by that party.
19. Name Change. Annamae may return to her maiden of Filiaga.
20. Dispute Resolution. If a dispute arises between the parties, they should attend mediation prior to filing an action in court, other than an enforcement action.
