IN THIS ACTION, Defendants Joshua Preston Wiseman and Megan Summer Martinez (the "Defendants"), having been served with process and having failed to appear and answer Plaintiff America First Federal Credit Union's Complaint on file herein, the legal time for answering having expired, and the default of the Defendants having been duly entered according to law, now upon application of Plaintiff to the Court, JUDGMENT IS HEREBY ENTERED as follows:

1. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendants, jointly and severally, for the amount due and owing to Plaintiff under the Note, as such term is defined in the Complaint, which is \$20,355.81, plus attorney's fees of \$1,446.50 and costs of \$461.20, for a total judgment of \$22,263.51, together with interest at the contract rate of 4.24% per annum from November 3, 2025, until paid in full;

2. The Dodge identified in the Complaint was recovered by America First Federal Credit Union ("America First"), and is in the process of being sold. Once the Dodge has been sold, America First shall apply the net sales proceeds the amount under this judgment to reduce the amount by the Defendants; and

3. It is further ordered that this judgment may be augmented in the amount of reasonable costs and attorney's fees expended in collecting the judgment by execution or otherwise, as allowed by statute or rule and approved by the Court.
