Defendants Atlatl Group, LLC, d/b/a Bravada Yachts LLC, Aaron Browning, and Robert Gutierrez (the "Defendants") being duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint on the 5th day of October 2023, through Direct Service pursuant to Rule 4.2(b) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure; and having failed to appear, plead or Answer thereto; the legal time thereof having expired, and not having been extended, the Default of said Defendants has been duly entered according to law, and, upon application and motion of said Plaintiff to the Court for the entry of Judgment in accordance with the prayer of the Complaint and the Plaintiff's Affidavits file herein,

1 and good cause appearing, it is hereby ORDERED that the Plaintiff shall have Judgment against
2 each of the Defendants, jointly and severally, for the principal sum of \$1,456,700 (damages for
3 fraud, unjust enrichment, and breach of contract), together with prejudgment interest from June 1,
4 2019 through January 9, 2024, in the amount of \$976,000.39, which interest shall continue to accrue
5 at \$693.72 per diem pursuant to the agreement between the parties, until paid in full, together with
6 Plaintiff's costs in the amount of \$719.56, and attorneys' fees in the amount of \$6,175.


