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THIS MATTER having come before the Court for entry of a Decree of Divorce, the Court having reviewed the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement entered into by the parties, and the record as a whole, and being fully advised in the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the Court's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which are hereby incorporated by reference, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

1. Dissolution of Marriage. The marriage between Petitioner, MIRIAM BARBOSA-SILVA, and Respondent, ROBERT KENNETH NUTTING, is hereby dissolved on the grounds of irreconcilable differences.
2. Incorporation of Stipulation. The Stipulation and Settlement Agreement signed by the parties on or about March 25, 2026, is hereby approved, incorporated into this Decree, and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
3. Children. There are no minor children born to or adopted by the parties. No orders regarding custody, parent-time, or child support are necessary.
4. Alimony. Respondent shall pay to Petitioner alimony in the amount of \$1,800.00 per month for a period of twenty-four (24) months.

Alimony shall commence on June 25, 2026, and shall be due on the 25th day of each month thereafter.

Alimony shall terminate upon the earliest of the following:

- Completion of twenty-four (24) months of payments;
- Death of either party;
- Petitioner's remarriage; or
- Petitioner's cohabitation as defined by Utah law.

5. Health Insurance. Respondent shall maintain health insurance coverage for Petitioner and her two children for a period of two (2) years from the entry of this Decree of Divorce.

6. Personal Property. The parties shall divide all personal property as mutually agreed between them.

7. Retirement Accounts. There are no retirement accounts, bank accounts, real property, or business interests acquired during the marriage to be divided.

8. Debts. Each party shall be solely responsible for his or her own debts and shall indemnify and hold the other harmless therefrom.

9. Documents. Each party shall execute and deliver any documents necessary to carry out the terms of this Decree.

10. General Provisions. This Decree is intended to be a final adjudication of all issues between the parties. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this Decree.

11. The Court may grant such further relief as is equitable and consistent with this Decree.


