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The above-captioned matter came before the Court without hearing. The Court, having reviewed the file, the Stipulation and Property Settlement Agreement (the “Stipulation”), and having entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, hereby ORDERS, ADJUDICATES, AND DECREES as follows:

GROUND AND JURISDICTION

1. The parties were lawfully married on October 12, 2018.

2. The parties have separated and irreconcilable differences have arisen.
3. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter.
4. There are no minor children of the marriage.

DIVORCE

1. The marriage between Rosa Moreno and Miguel Valdivia is hereby dissolved, and the parties are restored to the status of single persons.

INCORPORATION OF STIPULATION

1. The Stipulation and Property Settlement Agreement (Dkt. 2) is approved and incorporated into this Decree as though fully set forth herein. The parties are ordered to comply with its terms.

PROPERTY

1. Each party is awarded all real and personal property currently in his or her possession, except as otherwise provided in the Stipulation.
2. Each party shall retain any property acquired prior to the marriage and any gifts received during the marriage.
3. The parties shall cooperate to remove the other party's name from any jointly titled property within sixty (60) days of entry of this Decree.

DEBTS

4. Each party shall be responsible for debts incurred in his or her own name.
5. Each party shall indemnify and hold the other harmless from any debts allocated to that party.

6. Neither party shall incur any debt in the name of the other.

FINANCIAL MATTERS

7. Each party shall retain all financial accounts in his or her own name.
8. Neither party is awarded alimony.
9. Each party shall retain his or her own life insurance policies.

FEES AND NAME

10. Each party shall pay his or her own attorney fees and costs, except that the filing fee shall be shared equally.
11. Petitioner may resume use of her maiden name.
12. In the event of a dispute arising after entry of this Decree, the parties shall participate in mediation prior to filing any court action, except for enforcement actions.
13. A future spouse of either party shall have no right to seek modification of this Decree.

FINALITY

14. This Decree resolves all issues between the parties and constitutes a final judgment.
