The court decrees:

Divorce

1. **Jacob Moseh Willson** is granted a divorce based on his Affidavit of Jurisdiction and Grounds. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Children (Utah Code 78B-12-102(7))

2. **Jacob Moseh Willson** and **Emily Lavon Birkin** do not have any children together.
- They do not have any children together who are minors. A minor is a child under 18 who has not been married or otherwise emancipated.

Debts

5. The parties are not aware of any debts from the marriage. If any debts exist, each debt will be the responsibility of the party who incurred the debt.

Real property

6. The parties do not have any real property that is marital property. The parties do not need a court order about real property.

Alimony

7. Neither party will pay alimony.

Retirement money

8. The parties do not need a court order about retirement money.

Duty to sign documents

9. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
