The court decrees:

Divorce

Duty to sign documents




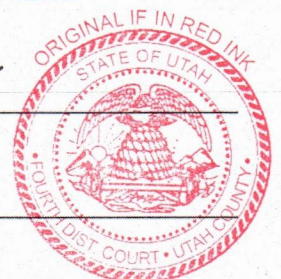
