BASED UPON the *Bifurcated Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law* filed herewith, IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. That the parties are hereby awarded a Bifurcated Decree of Divorce, said Decree is to become final upon its being signed by the Court and entered into the Office of the Fourth Judicial District Clerk.
2. **Residence.** The parties are residents of Utah County, State of Utah, and have been for at least three (3) months immediately prior to the commencement of this action.
3. **Marriage Information.** Jessica Glenn (hereinafter “Mother”) and Jesse Glenn (hereinafter “Father”) were married on December 18, 2020, and are currently married. The parties separated in July 2024.

4. **Grounds for Divorce.** Mother alleged grounds for the divorce in her Petition for Divorce (DN 2, ¶3) and Father alleged grounds for the divorce in his Counter Petition (DN 14, ¶5). Both parties alleged irreconcilable differences, among other claims. The Bifurcated Decree of Divorce is entered based on the grounds of irreconcilable differences and all other claims regarding grounds are reserved.

5. **General Jurisdiction.** This Court has general jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to Utah Code §78A-5-102(1).

6. **Personal Jurisdiction.** This Court has personal jurisdiction over the parties, pursuant to Utah Code §78B-3-205 and Utah Code §78B-15-604.

7. **Venue.** Venue is proper in this Court, pursuant to Utah Code §78B-15-605.

8. **Bifurcated Decree of Divorce.** Based upon this Court's orders, a Bifurcated Decree of Divorce shall be entered. Both parties shall sign and fully execute the final documents that are necessary to implement the provisions of the Bifurcated Decree of Divorce. All remaining issues not addressed in the decree are reserved for trial or further agreement of the parties.
