Petitioner, Doris Rubio Aldana, ("Wife"), by and through her attorney Lillian M. Reedy, and Respondent, Alberto Aldana, have determined that they desire to resolve the issue for divorce on the following factual basis. The Court having entered its FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, now orders as follows

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Petitioner is granted a divorce based on her Affidavit of Jurisdiction and Grounds, the divorce to become final upon entry.
2. **Children.** There are no children of the marriage.
3. **Personal Property.** During the course of the marriage relationship, the parties have acquired certain items of personal property. It is reasonable and equitable that this property be divided as follows:

a. Vehicles.

- i. During the marriage the parties acquired the following vehicles.

These vehicles shall be awarded as follows and its value equalized to the parties accordingly.

- b. Equalization of Property.** Husband shall pay Wife to equalize the division of assets and debts. Husband shall make monthly payments to Wife of \$500 starting May 1, 2025 for a time period of 60 months (April 1, 2030). This amount due to Wife shall survive either parties' death and cannot be divested from Husband's estate. If Husband does not pay by the 10th of each month or is delinquent more than 2 months, the full amount shall become due and payable

along with interest at a rate of 18% per annum. If collection is necessary, Husband is responsible to pay any reasonable attorney fees and costs to collect any amounts due.

c. **Bank/financial accounts.** The parties have separate bank accounts. Joint accounts have not been acquired during the marriage. Any marital amounts that are held in a sole are accounted for in the equalization payment. Each party is awarded his or her own bank account in his or her name.

d. **Retirement accounts.** Wife has a retirement account with the Utah State Retirement Systems. Wife shall be awarded her retirement account. Wife owns a Roth IRA at Farm Bureau valued at \$5,000 and it shall be awarded to Wife.

e. The parties shall be awarded their personal items. All other assets that are unknown and are discovered shall be split evenly between the parties.

4. **Debts.** During the course of the marriage, the parties may have acquired certain debts and obligations. It is reasonable and equitable that the debts be divided such that any debt acquired shall belong to the person in whose name the debt was acquired.

5. **Real Property.** The parties have acquired real property during the marriage. The Lehi property located at 526 South 800 West, Lehi was purchased during the marriage. The Real Property is awarded to Husband. Husband shall be responsible for the fees and costs to remove Wife from title to the house in the amount of \$250. Within 10 days of the entry of the Decree of Divorce, Wife shall sign and record a quitclaim deed with Utah County Records Office. When Respondent sells the house, he shall inform Wife of the sale and verify prior to the sale that all marital taxes are paid from the proceeds of the sale.
6. The Eagle Mountain property was acquired by Wife before the marriage in 2011. This Eagle Mountain property shall be confirmed as the sole property of the Wife.
7. **Business.** The Husband has acquired the business of *Jack Construction* with an unknown business value. A second business *El Salvador Food Truck* is owned by Wife. Her percentage of ownership is 25 percent with other owners outside of the marriage controlling 75%. These business properties and any related debts have been disclosed and valued. Each party is awarded their business, its debts, and one-half of their net value shall be paid or equalized to the other.
8. **Alimony.** The parties have enjoyed a plentiful standard of living during the marriage. While both parties worked, they are currently able to independently provide for their own needs. Both parties forever waive the right to alimony.
9. **Taxes.** The parties will file separate taxes for the tax year 2024 and 2025. Husband shall be solely responsible for all tax amounts owed to the IRS and the State.
10. **Health Insurance.** Health insurance will be maintained through the pendency of this action.

11. **Attorney's Fees.** Wife shall be responsible for attorney fees.
12. Both parties should be ordered to sign and fully execute whatever documents are necessary for the implementation of the provisions of this divorce decree. Should a party fail to execute a document within 60 days of entry of this divorce decree, the other party may bring an order to show cause at the expense of the disobedient party and seek that the court appoint some other person to execute the document pursuant to rule 70 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure. Any document executed search rule 70 has the same effect as if executed by the disobedient party. Each party shall attend the statutorily required divorce education courses.
13. Prior to any Petition being filed to change any provision of the final Decree of Divorce, the parties must attempt to resolve the issue through mediation.
14. Wife shall have the option of restoring her maiden name.
