The court decrees:

Divorce

1. Randy Cole Weintz is granted a divorce based on the Affidavit of Jurisdiction of Grounds. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Children (Utah Code 78B-12-102(7))

Personal Property (Utah Code 30-3-5)

Real Property

The parties do not have any real property that is marital property. The parties do not need a court order about real property.

Alimony

Neither party will pay alimony.

Retirement money – retirement accounts

All retirement accounts held in Petitioner's name will remain the sole and exclusive property of the Petitioner, and Respondent waives all right, title and interest, if any, in said accounts. All retirement accounts held in Respondent's name will remain the sole and exclusive property of the Respondent, and the Petitioner waives all right, title, and interest, if any, in said accounts.

Name after divorce

3. Respondent changed his/her name when the parties married. Respondent's name will be restored to Carissa Ann Huff after the divorce.

Duty to sign documents

4. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from the entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
