**DECREE OF ANNULMENT
OF MARRIAGE**

THE ABOVE-CAPTIONED MATTER comes before the Fourth District Court for consideration pursuant to Motion for Default, Decree of Annulment of Marriage and Notice to Submit. Petitioner submitted his Declaration of Jurisdiction and Grounds. There being on file in the record of these proceedings proof of service of Summons and Verified Petition for Annulment, and the evidence to establish jurisdiction and the grounds for the annulment having been presented through the Declaration, and the Court having heretofore made and entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and good cause appearing therefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

That the Petitioner is hereby granted an annulment from Respondent on the grounds of false pretenses pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §81-4-302.

1. **Residency.** Petitioner has been an actual and bona fide resident of Utah County, State of Utah for at least three (3) months prior to filing this action.

2. **Grounds for Annulment.** Soon after the date of the parties' marriage, Michael realized that he had married Ingredd under false pretenses. Ingredd is from Brazil and is not fluent in English. She told Michael that she has an F1 Student Visa and is not currently in classes because she is behind on payments. She also told Michael that she was worried about getting evicted from her apartment in Murray. Before the parties got married, Ingredd would prepare meals for Michael. She also offered to help with household tasks, as Michael had recently suffered a back injury. Two days after their marriage, Ingredd stopped cooking for Michael. Two weeks after their marriage, after moving in her clothing, furniture, and cleaning supplies, Ingredd left their home. She did not tell Michael when she would return. When Michael asked her to return home, she demanded that he pay her \$2,100 in cash. Michael responded that he did not have the funds to pay her that sum. Ingredd responded angrily, threatening that she will be deported if Michael does not pay for her overdue schooling fees. Ingredd returned to the home recently with a police escort to collect her belongings. Ingredd's abrupt abandonment of Michael indicates that she viewed their marriage as merely transactional. At the time of the marriage, Michael was unaware of Ingredd's intention to marry him for financial support. Had Michael made this realization earlier, he would not have married Ingredd.

3. **Marriage Statistics.** Michael and Ingredd are husband and wife having been married on December 22, 2025. The parties separated on or about January 5, 2026.

4. The parties have no minor children.
5. **Alimony**. The parties shall waive Alimony in this matter.
6. **Personal Property**. The parties shall divide their personal property between themselves.
7. **Real Property**. The parties do not own any real property.
8. **Vehicles**. The parties do not own any vehicles.
9. **Debts**. Each party shall be responsible for any debt which he/she personally incurred and shall indemnify and hold the other party harmless for said debts.
10. **Retirement Accounts**. The parties shall be entitled to the funds from their own retirement accounts.
11. **Bank Accounts**. The parties have maintained separate bank accounts and shall keep the monies associated with their individual accounts.
12. **Attorney's Fees and Costs**. Each party shall pay their own attorney's fees and court costs associated with this proceeding.
13. **Miscellaneous**. Neither party shall use the other party's likeness, picture, name, identification, or credit of the other party to obtain credit, open an account for any service, or obtain any other service.
