6. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** and **Andrae Leigh Griffin** have physical custody of our child(ren), and are the only people who have custody, child support, and parent-time rights to our child(ren).

PARENTING PLAN

This Parenting Plan is being filed in good faith.

This parenting plan is agreed to by **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** and **Andrae Leigh Griffin**.

Children - custody

(Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 9, Part 3)

7. It is in the children's best interest that the parties be awarded Joint Legal and Joint Physical Custody. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is filing this Parenting Plan and verifies the plan is filed in good faith.

8. The children should reside in **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** home **182** overnights each year and in **Andrae Leigh Griffin's** home **183** overnights each year.

Income: Petitioner (Raymond Walter Griffin Jr) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

9. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$20000**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** does not have any countable income from any source.
- b. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** does not have any income from employment.
- c. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is employed at **US Army**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** earns **\$8596** gross (pre-tax) monthly income working a 40-hour a week job or less.

Income: Respondent (Andrae Leigh Griffin) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

10. **Andrae Leigh Griffin's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$4167**. **Andrae Leigh Griffin** receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Andrae Leigh Griffin** is employed at **Utah Valley Univeristy**. **Andrae Leigh Griffin** earns **\$4167** gross (pre-tax) monthly income working a 40-hour a week job or less.

11. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Andrae Leigh Griffin** is **\$4167**.

12. The parents will follow the schedule for special occasions below. Parent-time transfers

13. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

Curbside transfers

14. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a

child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

Decision-making

15. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

Joint decision-making. The parents will share responsibility for making major decisions about the children. If there is a disagreement, the parents will resolve the dispute as provided in the Resolving disputes section below.

Education plan

16. The school the children will attend is based on **Andrae Leigh Griffin's** home residence.

17. Raymond Walter Griffin Jr and Andrae Leigh Griffin has authority to check the children out of school. Raymond Walter Griffin Jr and Andrae Leigh Griffin has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Andrae Leigh Griffin.

Communication with each other

18. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

Communication with the children

19. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

20. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By any method

Records and information sharing

21. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

Travel by the children

22. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.

23. If the children will be travelling for more than **2** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **2** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **2** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

Child care

24. A child care provider for our children must be:
A licensed child care provider.

Relocation of a parent (Utah Code 81-9-209)

25. If either parent moves more than 149 miles from the other, the moving parent must give the non-moving parent a written Notice of Relocation. The notice must be sent at least 60 days before the planned move.

- a. The written Notice of Relocation must include:
 - Information about the move;
 - A proposed parent-time schedule; and
 - A statement that the parents will not interfere with the other parent's parent-time.
- b. If the moving parent does not give the non-moving parent a Notice of Relocation, the moving parent will be in contempt of the court's order.

26. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other, or if the parents live a different countries, parent-time will be as the parties agree. If they are unable to agree, the following will be the minimum parent-time for the noncustodial parent:

Relocation Schedule (Utah Code 81-9-209)

- a. in years ending in odd number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
 - i. Thanksgiving holiday beginning Wednesday until Sunday; and
 - ii. spring break, if applicable, beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes;
- b. in years ending in an even number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:
 - i. the entire winter school break period; and
 - ii. the fall school break beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes; and
- c. extended parent-time equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the summer or off-track time for consecutive weeks. The children will be returned to the custodial home no later than seven days before school begins. This week will be counted when determining the amount of parent-time to be divided between the parents for the summer or off-track period. The parties will mutually agree on this extended time each year. If they are unable to agree, the noncustodial parent will select the dates for the extended time period.
- d. One weekend per month at the option and expense of the noncustodial parent. The noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement is subject to the following

restrictions.

i. If the noncustodial parent has not designated a specific weekend for parent-time, the noncustodial parent will receive the last weekend of each month unless a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on that particular weekend. If a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on the last weekend of the month, the noncustodial parent will be entitled to the next to the last weekend of the month.

ii. If a noncustodial parent's extended parent-time or parent-time over a holiday extends into or through the first weekend of the next month, that weekend will be considered the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement for that month.

iii. If a child is out of school for teacher development days or snow days after the children begin the school year, or other days not included in the list of holidays in Subsection (5) and those days are contiguous with the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend parent-time, those days will be included in the weekend parent-time.

e. The custodial parent is entitled to all parent-time not specifically allocated to the noncustodial parent.

27. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be shared equally.

28. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

29. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

Resolving disputes

30. If the parents need to resolve a dispute regarding the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for their children. If the parents are unable to agree, they will go to the following before bringing the issue to the court:

a. **Counseling**

Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

Military Parenting Plan (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 10, Part 4)

This Military Parenting Plan is proposed by the **petitioner**.

31. This Military Parenting Plan is in addition to the standard Parenting Plan because **Petitioner** is a servicemember.

Military Parenting Plan: Notice of deployment

32. After receiving notice of deployment, a deploying parent will give written notice to

the other parent within 7 days or as soon as reasonably possible. If the non-deploying parent has a protective order against the deploying parent, the deploying parent will give written notice of deployment to the court. The written notice of deployment should include the destination, duration, and conditions.

Military Parenting Plan: Caretaking authority during deployment

33. Only **Petitioner** is a servicemember. While **Petitioner** is deployed, caretaking authority of the parties' children is given to:

- **Andrae Leigh Griffin**, who is not deployed.
- **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** will keep some caretaking authority.

34. A person granted caretaking authority must notify the following people of any change in mailing or residential address:

- The deploying parent,
- Anyone with physical or legal custody,
- Anyone who has parent-time, right to access, visitation, and
- Anyone with authority to grant limited contact with the children.

35. However, if a person granted caretaking authority has a court order protecting their address, they must give written notice of any change in mailing or residential address to the court.

Military Parenting Plan: Decision-making authority during deployment

36. The people given caretaking authority above will have decision-making authority to:

- Make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children.
- Make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decisions with the other people who have caretaking authority as soon as reasonably possible.

Military Parenting Plan: Resolving disputes

37. If the people given caretaking authority need to resolve a dispute about the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for the children.

38. If the people given caretaking authority are unable to agree, they will participate in the following before bringing the issue to the court:

- a. Counseling

Military Parenting Plan: Contact with the deployed parent

39. There will be contact with the children and the deployed parent. **Andrae Griffin** will arrange for the contact. Contact will be as follows:

Frequency: daily

Duration: 1 hour

Method: skype

Military Parenting Plan: Contact when deployed parent is on leave or is otherwise available

40. When the deployed parent is on leave or is otherwise available, contact with the children will be as follows:

b. **The children can contact the deployed parent however and whenever they want. The deployed parent can contact the children anytime and any way they want.**

Military Parenting Plan: Child support not modified

41. Child support obligations cannot be modified by the Military Parenting Plan.

42. Changing child support requires a court order.

Military Parenting Plan: Terminating the plan

43. The arrangements in this Military Parenting Plan terminate immediately upon return.

44. A joint physical custody arrangement may result in denial of cash assistance under the Employment Support Act, Title 35A, Chapter 3, of the Utah Code.

END OF PARENTING PLAN

Income: Petitioner (Raymond Walter Griffin Jr) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

45. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$20000**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** base child support amount using the **joint** custody calculation is **\$3409**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives the following gross monthly income:

46. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$20000**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives the following gross monthly income:

a. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** does not have any countable income from any source.

b. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** has no recent work history. The court should consider **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** wage to be the federal minimum wage of **\$7.25** an hour.

This is a gross monthly income of **\$1257**. (Utah Code 81-6-203(6)(c) and (d))

c. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is **\$20000**.

d. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is voluntarily unemployed. Based on **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** work experience, **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is capable of earning **\$0.00** per hour, or **\$0** per month. (Utah Code 81-6-203)

e. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** occupation is unknown. The court should consider **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** wage to be the federal minimum wage of **\$7.25** an hour.

This is a gross monthly income of **\$1257**. (Utah Code 81-6-203(6)(c) and (d))

f. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is employed at **US Army**. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** earns **\$8596** gross (pre-tax) monthly income working a 40-hour a week job or less.

g. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is employed at **US Army** and grosses **\$8596** per month. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** is voluntarily underemployed and is capable of working at a job which pays more. Based upon **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** work experience,

gross monthly income should be attributed to **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** in the amount of **\$20000** per month. (Utah Code 81-6-203)

h. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** has normally and consistently earned **\$0** per month in overtime or additional employment above **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** full time pay.

This income counts for child support purposes. (Utah Code 81-6-203(2))

i. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives **\$0** per month in public benefits from social security, workers' compensation, unemployment compensation, income replacement disability insurance, Social Security Disability Insurance, or payments from "nonmeans-tested" government programs. This income counts for child support purposes. (Utah Code 81-6-203(2))

j. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives **\$0** per month in public benefits from the Family Employment Program (T.A.N.F./F.E.P). This income does not count for child support purposes. (Utah Code 81-6-203(7)).

k. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** receives **\$0** per month in public benefits from a housing subsidy program, the Job Training Partnership Act, Supplemental Security Income, Medicaid, SNAP, General Assistance, or other similar means-tested welfare benefits.

This income does not count for child support purposes, (Utah Code 81-6-203(7)).

l. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** has the following income from any of these sources:

68. **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr** must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Raymond Walter Griffin Jr's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Andrae Leigh Griffin's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:

- f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
- g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
- h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

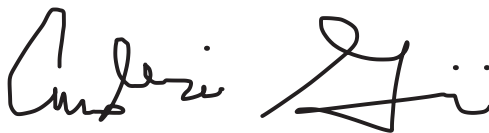
