This Parenting Plan is being filed in good faith.

This parenting plan is agreed to by **Steven Moon** and **Jessica Moon**.

Children - custody

(Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 9, Part 3)

7. It is in the children's best interest that **Jessica Moon** be awarded Sole Legal and Sole Physical custody **Steven Moon** should have parent-time at reasonable times and places.

Parent-time

8. The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule:

The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule.

a. **Transitional Parent-Time for Steven Moon and Hailey** The parties agree that **Jessica Moon** shall have full legal and primary physical custody of Hailey, subject to **Steven Moon's** parent-time as set forth below, as may be modified by mutual written agreement of **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** or further order of the Court. Hailey may need a gradual transition before exercising unsupervised parent-time with **Steven Moon**. The purpose of this transitional plan is to support Hailey's emotional comfort and best interests while allowing **Steven Moon** and Hailey to rebuild their relationship in a safe, healthy, and flexible manner. During the initial transitional period, **Steven Moon** shall have parent-time with Hailey one time per week, supervised by an adult mutually agreed upon by **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon**. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon**, these visits shall initially occur in a public location that is reasonably comfortable and appropriate for Hailey. **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** may consider input from Hailey, Hailey's therapist or mental health provider, and any other appropriate professional involved in Hailey's care when evaluating Hailey's readiness to transition toward unsupervised parent-time with **Steven Moon**. **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** acknowledge that Hailey's therapy provider may change and that establishing care with a new provider may take time. The transition shall not be delayed solely because Hailey is waiting to begin with a new therapist if **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** can otherwise agree on appropriate next steps consistent with Hailey's best interests. **Steven Moon** shall not drive Hailey while **Steven Moon's** driver's license is suspended or otherwise legally restricted in a way that prevents **Steven Moon** from lawfully driving Hailey. Once **Steven Moon's** driving privileges are legally restored, this restriction shall no longer apply unless otherwise agreed by **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** or ordered by the Court. As Hailey becomes more comfortable spending time with **Steven Moon**, **Jessica Moon** and **Steven Moon** may, by mutual written

agreement, modify the supervision requirement, location requirement, frequency, duration, and structure of Steven Moon's parent-time without a formal court modification, provided the changes are consistent with Hailey's best interests and do not conflict with any court order. Once Hailey is ready and comfortable spending unsupervised time with Steven Moon, Steven Moon's parent-time shall transition to the applicable Utah minimum parent-time schedule under Utah Code with Jessica Moon remaining the custodial/primary parent, unless Jessica Moon and Steven Moon mutually agree in writing to a different schedule or the Court orders otherwise. This provision is intended to provide a temporary and supportive transition for Hailey and is not intended to create a permanent restriction on Steven Moon's parent-time. Mental Health Treatment Steven Moon agrees to remain under the care of a qualified mental health provider for treatment and management of Steven Moon's mental health, including bipolar disorder, anxiety, PTSD, and any related conditions for which Steven Moon is receiving care. Steven Moon is currently working with Lisa Olsen but may work with another qualified provider if Lisa Olsen is unavailable or if Steven Moon changes providers. Steven Moon agrees to attend appointments with Steven Moon's treating provider at least once every six months, or more frequently if recommended by Steven Moon's treating provider, and to follow Steven Moon's provider-recommended treatment plan, including medication management, therapy, follow-up appointments, or other recommended care. All treatment decisions, including medication type, dosage, medication changes, appointment frequency, diagnosis, therapy recommendations, and other medical or mental health recommendations, shall remain between Steven Moon and Steven Moon's treating provider. Upon Jessica Moon's written request, Steven Moon shall provide a brief written statement from Steven Moon's treating provider confirming that Steven Moon is under the provider's care and participating in treatment. Such confirmation shall not require Steven Moon to disclose detailed medical records, therapy notes, specific medications, medication dosages, private treatment details, or other protected health information unless Steven Moon voluntarily agrees or the Court orders otherwise. This provision is intended to support Hailey's comfort and best interests during the transitional parent-time period and is not intended to give Jessica Moon control over Steven Moon's medical treatment or allow Jessica Moon to substitute Jessica Moon's judgment for the judgment of Steven Moon's treating provider.

Parent-time for special occasions

9. The parents will follow the schedule for special occasions below. If there is more than one child and the children's school schedules vary for purpose of a holiday, at the option

of the parent exercising the holiday or the parent's half of the holiday, the children may remain together for the holiday period beginning the first evening that all children's schools are let out for the holiday and ending the evening before any child returns to school. (Utah Code 81-9-302, 303).

Parent-time transfers

10. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

Curbside transfers

11. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

Decision-making

12. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the

decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

Education plan

13. The school the children will attend is based on **Jessica Moon**'s home residence.

14. Jessica Moon has authority to check the children out of school. Jessica Moon has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Jessica Moon.

Communication with the children

16. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

17. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By any method

Records and information sharing

18. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

Travel by the children

19. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.

20. If the children will be travelling for more than **7** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **60** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **14** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

Child care

21. A child care provider for our children must be:

A licensed child care provider.

A relative, friend, or neighbor.

Relocation of a parent (Utah Code 81-9-209)

22. If either parent moves more than 149 miles from the other, the moving parent must give the non-moving parent a written Notice of Relocation. The notice must be sent at least 60 days before the planned move.

a. The written Notice of Relocation must include:

- Information about the move;
- A proposed parent-time schedule; and
- A statement that the parents will not interfere with the other parent's parent-time.

b. If the moving parent does not give the non-moving parent a Notice of Relocation, the moving parent will be in contempt of the court's order.

23. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other, or if the parents live in different countries, parent-time will be as the parties agree. If they are unable to agree, the following will be the minimum parent-time for the noncustodial parent:

Relocation Schedule (Utah Code 81-9-209)

a. in years ending in odd number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:

- i. Thanksgiving holiday beginning Wednesday until Sunday; and
- ii. spring break, if applicable, beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes;

b. in years ending in an even number, the minor children will spend the following holidays with the noncustodial parent:

- i. the entire winter school break period; and
- ii. the fall school break beginning the last day of school before the holiday until the day before school resumes; and

c. extended parent-time equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the summer or off-track time for consecutive weeks. The children will be returned to the custodial home no later than seven days before school begins. This week will be counted when determining the amount of parent-time to be divided between the parents for the summer or off-track period. The parties will mutually agree on this extended time each year. If they are unable to agree, the noncustodial parent will select the dates for the extended time period.

d. One weekend per month at the option and expense of the noncustodial parent. The noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement is subject to the following restrictions.

i. If the noncustodial parent has not designated a specific weekend for parent-time, the noncustodial parent will receive the last weekend of each month unless a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on that particular weekend. If a holiday assigned to the custodial parent falls on the last weekend of the month, the noncustodial parent will be entitled to the next to the last weekend of the month.

ii. If a noncustodial parent's extended parent-time or parent-time over a holiday extends into or through the first weekend of the next month, that weekend will be

considered the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend entitlement for that month.

iii. If a child is out of school for teacher development days or snow days after the children begin the school year, or other days not included in the list of holidays in Subsection (5) and those days are contiguous with the noncustodial parent's monthly weekend parent-time, those days will be included in the weekend parent-time.

e. The custodial parent is entitled to all parent-time not specifically allocated to the noncustodial parent.

24. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be paid by the **the parent who moved**.

25. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

26. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

30. **Steven Moon** believes the guideline amount for child support is unjust, inappropriate, or not in the best interest of our children for the following reasons:

The reason(s) for deviation are agreed amount.

31. It is in the best interest of the children that be ordered to pay child support to as follows:

- a. **\$2,155.00** per month. This deviates from the Utah Uniform Child Support Guidelines.
- b. Unless the Court orders otherwise, support for each child ends when:

- a child turns 18 or has graduated from high school during the child's normal and expected year of graduation, whichever occurs later, or
- a child dies, marries, becomes a member of the United States armed forces, or is emancipated (Utah Code 78A-6-801).

32. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

33. will give the information needed to set up direct deposit through 's employer. Once has the information, will have 's employer set up direct deposit to an account of 's choice. One half of the child support is due by the 5th of each month, and the other half is due by the 20th of each month.

34. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

35. **Steven Moon** will pay any ORS fees. If is the ORS applicant and the fees are withheld from payments to , will reimburse .

36. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

37. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

Dependent children for tax purposes

38. **Jessica Moon** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes.

Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

39. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

40. **Steven Moon** must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Steven Moon's** insurance will be primary coverage.

- **Jessica Moon's** insurance will be secondary coverage.
- b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:
 - **Steven Moon's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
 - **Jessica Moon's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.
- d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.
- e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.
- f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
- g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
- h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

41. Both parties will equally share all reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses.
- a. The party who pays child care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and identity of the child care provider. This must be done when a provider is first hired, and any time the other party asks for the information. The party incurring or paying child care expenses must notify the other party of any change of a child care provider or monthly expense. This must be done within 30 calendar days of the change.
 - b. The party not directly paying for child care must pay their share of child care expenses as soon as they receive verification of the expenses.
 - c. If a party does **not** follow the order and provide written verification, they may not receive credit for work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

Once Steven Moon's driving privileges are legally restored, this restriction shall no longer apply unless otherwise agreed by Jessica Moon and Steven Moon or ordered by the Court. As Hailey becomes more comfortable spending time with Steven Moon, Jessica Moon and Steven Moon may, by mutual written agreement, modify the supervision requirement, location requirement, frequency, duration, and structure of Steven Moon's parent-time without a formal court modification, provided the changes are consistent with Hailey's best interests and do not conflict with any court order. Once Hailey is ready and comfortable spending unsupervised time with Steven Moon, Steven Moon's parent-time shall transition to the applicable Utah minimum parent-time schedule under Utah Code with Jessica Moon remaining the custodial/primary parent, unless Jessica Moon and Steven Moon mutually agree in writing to a different schedule or the Court orders otherwise. This provision is intended to provide a temporary and supportive transition for Hailey and is not intended to create a permanent restriction on Steven Moon's parent-time. Mental Health Treatment Steven Moon agrees to remain under the care of a qualified mental health provider for treatment and management of Steven Moon's mental health, including bipolar disorder, anxiety, PTSD, and any related conditions for which Steven Moon is receiving care. Steven Moon is currently working with Lisa Olsen but may work with another qualified provider if Lisa Olsen is unavailable or if Steven Moon changes providers. Steven Moon agrees to attend appointments with Steven Moon's treating provider at least once every six months, or more frequently if recommended by Steven Moon's treating provider, and to follow Steven Moon's provider-recommended treatment plan, including medication management, therapy, follow-up appointments, or other recommended care. All treatment decisions, including medication type, dosage, medication changes, appointment frequency, diagnosis, therapy recommendations, and other medical or mental health recommendations, shall remain between Steven Moon and Steven Moon's treating provider. Upon Jessica Moon's written request, Steven Moon shall provide a brief written statement from Steven Moon's treating provider

confirming that Steven Moon is under the provider's care and participating in treatment. Such confirmation shall not require Steven Moon to disclose detailed medical records, therapy notes, specific medications, medication dosages, private treatment details, or other protected health information unless Steven Moon voluntarily agrees or the Court orders otherwise. This provision is intended to support Hailey's comfort and best interests during the transitional parent-time period and is not intended to give Jessica Moon control over Steven Moon's medical treatment or allow Jessica Moon to substitute Jessica Moon's judgment for the judgment of Steven Moon's treating provider.

Duty to sign documents

68. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
