The Court, having previously entered its Decree of Divorce and Judgment on December 18, 2025, having reviewed Petitioner's Affidavit of Non-Payment and Request for Judgment, and having entered its Order on Motion to Enforce Domestic Order on March 3, 2026, hereby enters the following Judgment:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. **Retirement Equalization Judgment.** Judgment is entered in favor of Petitioner Carol A. Bak and against Respondent Lorrin J. Price in the amount of \$42,482.21.
2. **Attorney/LPP Fees and Costs.** Pursuant to the Court's Order on Motion to Enforce Domestic Order and based upon Petitioner's Declaration of LPP Fees and Costs, Judgment is entered in favor of Petitioner Carol A. Bak and against Respondent Lorrin J. Price for LPP fees and costs in the amount of \$1,262.36.
3. **Statutory Interest.** The amounts awarded herein shall accrue post-judgment interest at the rate of 5.51% per annum pursuant to Utah Code § 15-1-4, commencing January 31, 2026, and continuing until paid in full.
4. **Total Judgment.** The total amount presently due and owing from Respondent Lorrin J. Price to Petitioner Carol A. Bak is:
