7. It is in the children's best interest that **Gabriela Villalobos** be awarded Sole Legal and Sole Physical custody **Jhonattan Villalobos** should have parent-time at reasonable times and places.

Parent-time

8. The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule:

The parents will follow a custom parent-time schedule.

a. **Children will be with Gabriela Villalobos full time. Jhonattan Villalobos will contact Gabriela Villalobos via text to arrange meeting times with children.**

Parent-time for special occasions

9. The parents will follow the schedule for special occasions below. If there is more than one child and the children's school schedules vary for purpose of a holiday, at the option of the parent exercising the holiday or the parent's half of the holiday, the children may remain together for the holiday period beginning the first evening that all children's schools are let out for the holiday and ending the evening before any child returns to school. Parent-time transfers

10. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

Curbside transfers

11. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

Decision-making

12. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

Education plan

13. The school the children will attend is based on **Gabriela Villalobos's** home residence.
14. Gabriela Villalobos has authority to check the children out of school. Gabriela Villalobos has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Gabriela Villalobos.

Communication with each other

15. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

Communication with the children

16. The parents agree they will:
- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
 - give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.
17. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.
- By any method

Records and information sharing

18. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

Travel by the children

19. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.
20. If the children will be travelling for more than **4** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **14** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **7** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.
21. Other agreements about travel by the children: **The parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent of all participants that will be traveling with parent and children. The parent arranging the travel will have an available phone at all times. The parent arranging the travel will assure children will have appropriate car seats if needed.**

Child care

22. A child care provider for our children must be:

Over the age of 18.

Other qualifications: **Gabriela Villalobos must approve childcare provider.**

Relocation of a parent

23. Neither parent may relocate with the minor children more than **150** miles from their current residence without a written agreement signed by the parties or further court order.

24. Other terms about relocating: **Custody will remain the same if either parent relocates.**

25. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be paid by **the the parent who moved.**

26. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

27. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

END OF PARENTING PLAN

Income: Petitioner (Gabriela Villalobos) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

28. **Gabriela Villalobos's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$0**. **Gabriela Villalobos** base child support amount using the **sole** custody calculation is **\$281**. **Gabriela Villalobos** receives the following gross monthly income:

29. **Jhonattan Villalobos's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$0**. **Jhonattan Villalobos's** base child support amount using the **sole** custody calculation is **\$1374**. **Jhonattan Villalobos** receives the following gross monthly income:

30. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Jhonattan Villalobos** is **\$7000**.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

31. It is in the best interest of the children that be ordered to pay child support to as follows:

a. **\$1,374.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

32. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code

Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

33. The **sole** custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

Gabriela Villalobos's base child support amount is **\$281** per month.

Jhonattan Villalobos's base child support amount is **\$1374** per month.

If physical custody of a child changes from what the court orders:

- The parent owing support must pay the support amount to whomever has physical custody of the child.
- The parent must pay the support amount without asking the court to modify the child support order.
- This does not apply to temporary parent-time changes. (Utah Code 81-6-104(4) and 81-6-205(8)(a)).

Child support reduction for extended parent-time

34. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

35. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

36. The person ordered to receive child support can request mandatory income withholding (Utah Code 62A-11 parts 4 and 5). If support is past due, the State of Utah may take federal or state tax refunds or rebates and apply the amounts to the child support owed.

- a. Withheld income will be sent to the Office of Recovery Services (ORS) until all past-due support is paid. Child support payments will be sent to:
150 East Center Street, Suite 2100 Provo, Utah 84606
unless ORS gives notice that payments should be sent elsewhere.

37. If ORS begins mandatory income withholding, child support is due on the first day of each month and will be past due on the first day of the next month.

38. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

39. **Gabriela Villalobos** and **Jhonattan Villalobos** will each pay half of any ORS fee.

- a. If a fee is withheld from payments to , will reimburse for half the fee.

40. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

41. The parties can ask to change this child support order by motion after three years from the date of its entry if:

- there is a difference of 10% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines,
- the difference is not temporary, and
- the amount previously ordered was not a deviation from the child support guidelines.

If the children receive TANF funds at the time an adjustment is sought, ORS will review the order and ask the court to adjust the amount if appropriate. (Utah Code 62A-11-306.2).

42. The parties can ask to change this child support order at any time by petition if there has been a substantial change in circumstances because of material changes in:

- custody;
- the relative wealth or assets of the parties;
- income of a parent of 30% or more;
- the employment potential and ability of a parent to earn;
- the medical needs of the child; or
- the legal responsibilities of either parent for the support of others.

(Utah Code 81-6-202 and 81-6-212)

The change must result in a difference of 15% or more between the amount previously ordered and the new amount of child support under the Utah child support guidelines.

The difference may not be temporary.

The court can consider natural or adoptive children born after the entry of the decree other than those in common to both parties as part of a request to modify an existing award subject to limitations in the law. (Utah Code 81-6-202(8))

43. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

Dependent children for tax purposes

44. **Gabriela Villalobos** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes.

Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

45. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

46. Parents must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not

available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

- a. Responsibility for child medical and dental expenses will be as follows:
- b. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:
 - **Gabriela Villalobos's** insurance will be primary coverage.
 - **Jhonattan Villalobos's** insurance will be secondary coverage.
- c. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:
 - **Gabriela Villalobos's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
 - **Jhonattan Villalobos's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- d. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.
- e. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.
- f. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.
- g. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
- h. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
- i. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

47. Both parties will equally share all reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses.

- a. The party who pays child care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and identity of the child care provider. This must be done when a provider is first hired, and any time the other party asks for the information. The party incurring or paying child care expenses must notify the other party of any change of a child care provider or monthly expense. This must be done within 30 calendar days of the change.
- b. The party not directly paying for child care must pay their share of child care expenses as soon as they receive verification of the expenses.
- c. If a party does **not** follow the order and provide written verification, they may not receive credit for work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

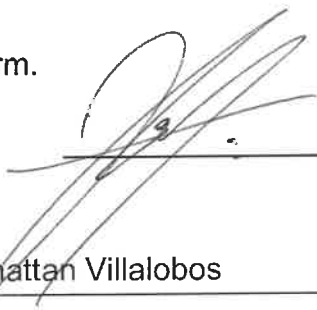
