On Plaintiff's Third Cause of Action: For all attorney fees incurred as consequential damages incurred in this action, in the sum of \$2,120.00 (if the entire current debt is collected), plus interest to accrue at the statutory rate of 5.51% per annum from April 2, 2026, until paid, plus costs accruing after Judgment.
