THE COURT, having reviewed the pleadings, having heard argument from the parties and counsel and being fully informed on the premises, and having entered the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and for good cause appearing, hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES and DECREES as follows:

Bifurcated Decree of Divorce

In the Matter of the Marriage of Jackson Kennedy and Alexis Meinzer

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1. Alexis is a bona fide resident of Wasatch County, State of Utah, and has been for at least three months immediately prior to filing this action.

2. Jackson and Alexis were married on October 19, 2024, in Wasatch County and are presently married. The parties separated on or about October 24, 2024.

3. During the course of the marriage the parties have experienced difficulties that cannot be reconciled, which have prevented the parties from pursuing a viable marriage relationship.

4. The bonds of matrimony existing between the parties are hereby dissolved and the parties are awarded a divorce absolute, dissolution of marriage, from each other on the grounds of irreconcilable differences, final upon entry of this Bifurcated Decree of Divorce.

5. Jackson and Alexis are hereby granted a Bifurcated Decree of Divorce from the other, and their marriage is hereby dissolved.

6. All remaining issues are hereby reserved.
